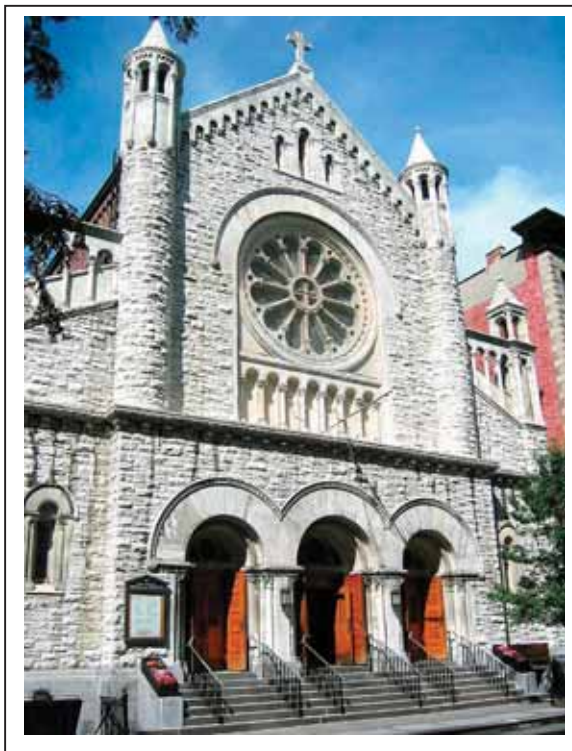

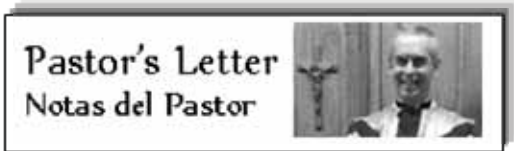

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

Next Sunday, we welcome Bishop John O'Hara to Ascension Church. Bishop O'Hara is one of New York's newest auxiliary bishops. Next Sunday, October 18th, we will combine the 11:00a.m. English Mass and the 12:30p.m. Spanish Mass and have a Bilingual Mass at 12:00 Noon. When Bishop O'Hara was here to celebrate with us the Sacrament of Confirmation in May, he liked our liturgy very much and expressed a desire to come back for a 'regular' Sunday Mass. At the Mass next Sunday, Bishop O'Hara will also bless the many items that were donated by our parishioners from our recently published parish 'wish list.' Folks were very generous in responding; new chalices have been donated for distribution of the cup at Mass, and also a new processional cross along with processional candles, new cassocks for altar servers, a new funeral set (chasuble and pall), a new donation box for the front of the church, a new clock, and the new Ascension banner which hangs outside. Each of these items will be blessed by Bishop O'Hara at next Sunday's liturgy.

In 1926, Pope Pius XI instituted World Mission Sunday. He asked for prayer, animation, celebration, and offerings for the Missions. His concern was to engender a sense of responsibility in people for supporting the Missions throughout the world. The first commemoration was in 1927 and the Pope asked that it would be observed in every diocese, parish and institute. It was to be a true World Mission Sunday. The collection on that first World Mission Sunday, like today, is for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, providing support for the life-giving and hope filled work and witness of priests, religious and lay pastoral leaders in mission churches. Next weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday. This year we are invited to support the 1,150 of the youngest dioceses in Africa, Asia, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe. Please always keep the Missions in your prayers.



In the meantime, please pray for the success of this Synod of Bishops on the Family as they reflect on family life in the modern world.

Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,

El próximo domingo le damos la bienvenida al obispo John O'Hara a la Iglesia de la Ascensión. El obispo O'Hara es uno de los más nuevos obispos auxiliares. El próximo domingo combinaremos la misa en inglés de las 11 de la mañana y la misa en español de las 12:30 de la tarde y tendremos una misa bilingüe a las 12 del mediodía. Cuando el obispo O'Hara estuvo aquí para celebrar con nosotros el sacramento de la confirmación en mayo, le gustó mucho nuestra liturgia y expresó el deseo de regresar para una misa "regular" del domingo. En la misa del próximo domingo, el obispo O'Hara también bendecirá los muchos artículos que fueron donados por nuestros feligreses, sacados de la "lista de deseos" parroquial recientemente publicada. La gente fue muy generosa en responder -- cálices nuevos fueron donados para la distribución de la copa en la misa y una cruz procesional junto con candeleros procesionales, nuevas sotanas para los monaguillos, un juego nuevo de funerales (casulla y portador del féretro), una caja nueva de donaciones para la parte de atrás de la iglesia, un reloj nuevo y una bandera nueva de la Ascensión que está colgada afuera. Cada uno de estos artículos será bendecido por el obispo O'Hara en la liturgia del próximo domingo.

En el 1926, el Papa Pío XI instituyó el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. Él pidió oración, ánimo, celebración y ofrendas para las misiones. Su preocupación era engendrar un sentido de responsabilidad en la gente para el apoyo de las misiones a través del mundo. La primera conmemoración fue en el 1927 y el papa pidió que fuera observada en cada diócesis, parroquia e instituto. Debería ser un verdadero Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. La colecta en ese primer Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, como hoy día, es para la Sociedad de la Propagación de la Fe, que provee apoyo al trabajo que salva vidas y está lleno de esperanza y el testimonio de sacerdotes, religiosos/as y dirigentes pastorales laicos en iglesias de misiones. El próximo fin de semana celebramos el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones. Este año estamos invitados a apoyar a la 1,150 diócesis más nuevas en el África, Asia, las Islas Pacíficas y partes de Latino América y Europa. Por favor, siempre mantenga a las misiones en sus oraciones.

Mientras tanto, por favor, ore por el éxito del Sínodo de Obispos Sobre la Familia, mientras ellos reflejan sobre la vida familiar en tiempos modernos.

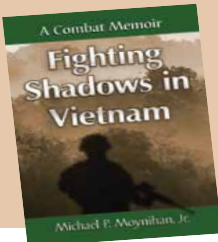
