The Creed

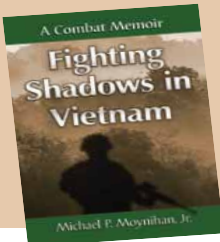

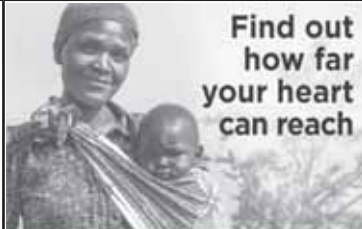
