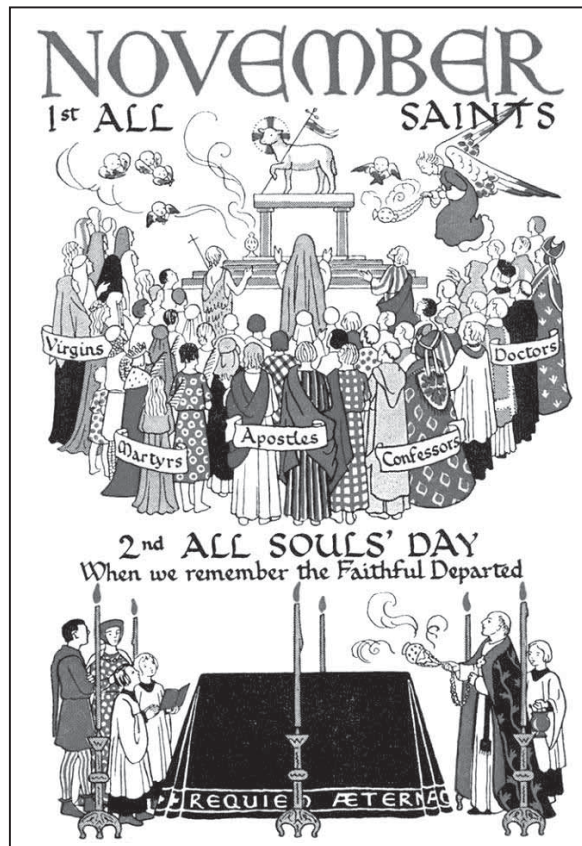

Pastor's Letter
Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

Today in the church, we will celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints and tomorrow we celebrate the Commemoration of All Souls. This is one of those rare feasts that take precedence over the Sunday celebration and the Sunday readings.

The celebration of All Souls is associated with the doctrine of the Communion of Saints. In reality, these two days, All Saints and All Souls should better be celebrated as one great feast. What we celebrate, in fact, on these two days, is the doctrine of the Communion of Saints. We believe that the communion of saints is made up of three groups of people, those on pilgrimage (us), those who are in a process of purification (purgatory), and those who are in heaven, experiencing the beatific vision, seeing God face to face. This, in fact, is what is celebrated on November 1st and November 2nd. In the Book of Maccabees we are reminded that it is a good and holy thing to pray for the dead (2 Maccabees (43-46)). For that reason, we pray in a special way during this month of November for all those who have died.

It was one year ago this weekend, when the parish Finance Committee first presented to us the campaign, "We can do this together." In this past year, people have been very responsive and for that we are sincerely grateful. We are still a bit shy of the ambitious goal that was set before us one year ago. To that end, the Finance Committee is preparing to update us as to where we now stand financially. They will make a presentation at each of the Masses next weekend.

Por esta razón, oramos de una manera especial durante este mes de noviembre por todos los que han fallecido.

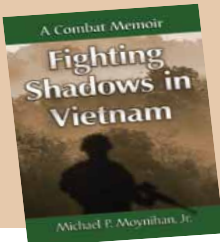
