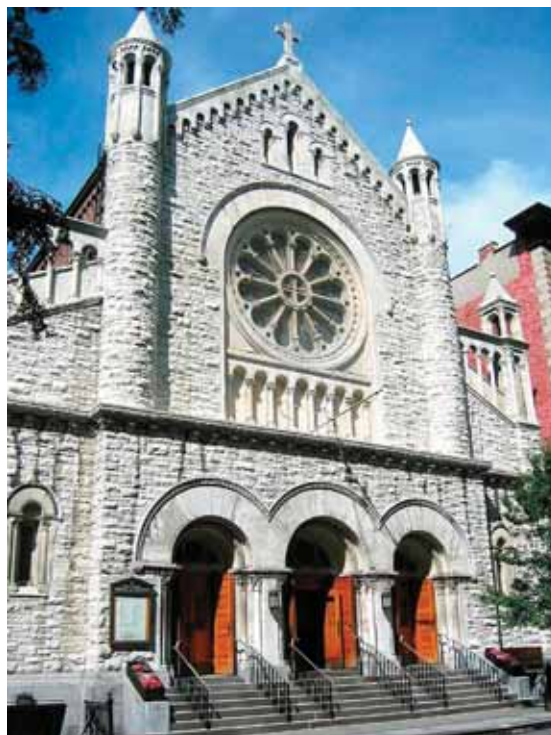

Pastor's Letter
Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

The Season of Lent is meant to be a time to draw us closer to the Lord. The church invites us to do so through the disciplines of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Specifically, Lent is meant to be a time of heightened prayer, penance and preparation so that we may worthily celebrate the resurrection of Jesus.

Every Friday we have all day adoration. On Friday, March 11th, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at the regular time, 6:30a.m. After the 7:00p.m. evening Mass, the Sacrament will again be exposed and the church will remain open all night. The 24-hour adoration will conclude with benediction of the Blessed Sacrament on Saturday morning, March 12th at 7:00a.m. Some group leaders have made a list to be sure that all hours of the night are covered. All are invited to come and spend some quiet time with the Lord. Pope Francis said, "In (our) visits and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, we experience the closeness of the good Shepherd, the tenderness of His love, the presence of a faithful friend. We ... all experience this large support in our lives provided by faith and our personal and intimate dialogue with the Lord in the Eucharist."



This weekend, we will have our in-pew solicitation of the Annual Cardinal's Appeal. Many have already received letters from Cardinal Dolan and many have responded. Thank you! The in-pew solicitation is geared towards those who have not already made a pledge. This weekend, envelopes and pencils will be available at all the Masses. Hopefully all have been able to give this some prayerful consideration. If each family were to consider a donation to the appeal, then surely we will make our goal that has been set at \$50,500.

And finally, I wish to remind you about our Culinary Dinner next Saturday evening. Most Friday evenings, I am privileged to be treated to a sumptuously prepared meal along with good fellowship and community. Part of the beauty of Ascension Parish is the sense of community that has been created through programs like the ACI. Ascension's Culinary Institute is a program designed for youth and children, ages 12 and up. Each Friday evening they are taught how to do everything from prepping the food, to preparing the meal, to setting the table, to cleaning the kitchen. Aside from learning how to cook and knowing their way around a kitchen, this program builds teamwork, camaraderie, self-confidence and a taste for the unknown. Next Saturday evening is our Annual Culinary Fundraiser. There will be a wonderful 7 course meal prepared by our students. Reservations are required. 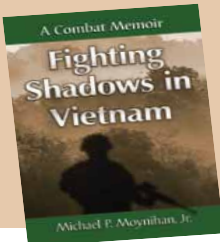
