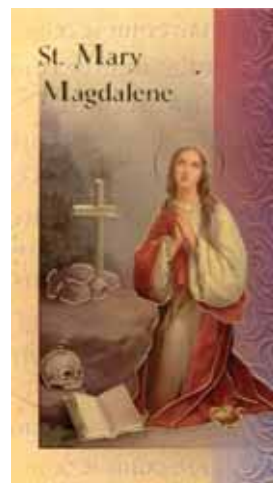
Pastor's Letter
Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

This Friday, July 22nd we honor the person of St. Mary Magdalene. This year the celebration is a bit different. As most know, the liturgical year is punctuated by celebrating various events important to the mystery of our salvation. During the course of the liturgical year, we celebrate everything from the incarnation and birth of Jesus to His Resurrection, Ascension, and Pentecost. On Sundays in particular, we commemorate the Resurrection, when Jesus triumphed over sin and death. In a special way, the Church also honors Mary, marking those special events of her participation in the mystery of salvation. Finally, the Church also commemorates the memorial days of saints, who through their lives remind us of our call to holiness. Saints' days are celebrated with few exceptions on the date of the saint's death.

Saints days are celebrated one of three ways, as either solemnities, feasts or memorials. Solemnities are the celebrations of greatest importance. On these days, both the Gloria and the Creed are recited. Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation are always considered solemnities. Other examples of solemnities include the Solemnity of St. Joseph (March 19), the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul (June 29). Feasts are of second importance in the liturgical calendar and are celebrated on a particular day. Next in line are memorials. A memorial may be obligatory or optional. Obligatory memorials must be observed whereas optional memorials do not have to be observed or celebrated. For example, the memorial of St. John Bosco (January 31) is obligatory while the memorial of St. Blase (February 3) is optional.

Up until very recently, July 22nd was celebrated as the Memorial of St. Mary Magdalene. Recognizing Mary Magdalene's special role as the first to witness the resurrection and as a "true and authentic evangelizer," Pope Francis has raised the July 22nd memorial of St. Mary Magdalene to a feast on the Church's liturgical calendar. The pope issued a decree to formalize this along with an article explaining its significance. Both the decree and the article are named "Apostle of the Apostles." Pope Francis has taken this decision precisely during the Jubilee Year of Mercy to highlight the relevance of this woman who showed great love for Christ and was much loved by Christ. Again, while most liturgical celebrations of individual saints during the year are known formally as memorials, those classified as feasts are reserved for important events in Christian history and for saints of particular significance. Mary Magdalene is now one of them. St. Mary Magdalene, pray for us!

Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,

Este viernes, 22 de julio, honramos la persona que fue María Magdalena. Como muchos saben, el año litúrgico está puntualizado por la celebración de varios eventos importantes para el misterio de nuestra salvación. Durante el curso del año litúrgico, celebramos todo desde la encarnación y nacimiento de Jesús hasta su resurrección, ascensión y Pentecostés. Los domingos, en particular, conmemoramos la resurrección, cuando Jesús triunfó sobre el pecado y la muerte. De una manera especial, la Iglesia también honra a María, marcando esos eventos especiales de su participación en el misterio de la salvación. Finalmente, la Iglesia también conmemora los días memoriales de los santos que, a través de sus vidas, nos recuerdan nuestro llamado a la santidad. Los días de los santos, con pocas excepciones, se celebran en las fecha de la muerte del santo.

Los días de los santos se celebran en una de tres maneras – como solemnidades, fiestas o memoriales. Las solemnidades son las celebraciones de más importancia. En estos días, el gloria y el credo son rezados. Los domingos y los días de precepto siempre están considerados como solemnidades. Otros ejemplos de solemnidades incluyen la Solemnidad de San José (19 de marzo), la Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús (3 de julio) y la Solemnidad de San Pedro y San Pablo (29 de junio). Las fiestas son de segunda importancia en el calendario litúrgico y se celebran en un día en particular. Por último, están los memoriales. Un memorial puede ser de precepto u opcional. Memoriales de precepto deben ser observados, mientras que memoriales opcionales no tienen que ser observados ni celebrados. Por ejemplo, el memorial de San Juan Bosco (31 de enero) es día de precepto, mientras que el memorial de San Blas (3 de febrero) es opcional.



Hasta hace muy poco, el 22 de julio se celebraba como el memorial de Santa María Magdalena. Reconociendo el papel especial de María Magdalena como el primer testigo de la resurrección y como una “verdadera y auténtica evangelizadora,” el Papa Francisco ha elevado el memorial de María Magdalena del 22 de julio a una fiesta en el calendario litúrgico de la Iglesia. El papa publicó un decreto para formalizar esto junto con un artículo explicando su significado. Tanto el decreto al igual que el artículo son titulados, “Apóstol de los apóstoles.” El Papa Francisco ha tomado esta decisión precisamente durante el Jubileo del Año de la Misericordia para destacar la relevancia de esta mujer que demostró gran amor por Cristo y que fue muy amada por Cristo. Una vez más, mientras la mayoría de las celebraciones litúrgicas de santos individuales durante el año son conocidas formalmente como memoriales, aquellas clasificadas como fiestas son reservadas para eventos importantes en la historia cristiana y para santos de significado particular. María Magdalena es ahora una de ellas. Santa María Magdalena, ¡ruega por nosotros!

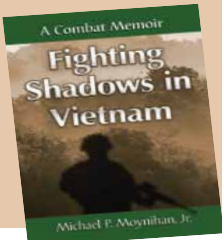
