Pastor's Letter Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

Today is Gaudate Sunday. Gaudate Sunday is always celebrated on the third Sunday of Advent. "Gaudate" Sunday, which is taken from the first word of the entrance antiphon, means rejoice. The penitential purple of Advent is replaced with rose, the color of joy.

Today the third candle on the Advent Wreath is lit. Today's liturgy gives a hint that something is on the horizon. Possibly dating back to the middle ages, when the season of Advent bore an overly penitential character, the rose color signaled joyfully that the church was close to Christmas. Although today the rose color is still a sign of anticipatory Christmas joy, we understand the continuity of Advent as a season of joyful expectation. Today's liturgy helps heighten that expectation which will carry through to the celebration of Christmas.

In many Latin American countries, it is a custom to celebrate a novena of Masses on the mornings immediately preceding Christmas. These masses are typically called 'aguinaldos.' To that end, we will celebrate these early morning Masses for the days before the 25th of December (including Saturday and Sunday). The Masses will begin on Saturday, December 17th. The Masses will be at 6:00a.m., followed by some hot chocolate or coffee. The Masses will be celebrated in Spanish. These are masses with music and they are very uplifting. All are invited to attend.

From your Finance Committee: For us as a Community of Believers, we have a lot for which to REJOICE this year. In keeping with our vein of "We Can Do it Together as an Ascension Community", we are asking this year for two Christmas gifts to Ascension Church. The first would be a monetary gift of \$250 - \$500 if you are able to provide one, but any extra donation is greatly appreciated. The second gift is signing up for the automated gift-giving system known as Faith Direct (see Faith Direct's website - Ascension Church's Code is "NY588"). We have added many parishioners to Faith Direct over the couple of years, but in order to be a financially self-sustaining Parish we need more support for Faith Direct. While we know much is being asked, we hope all would see the sacrifice as having great value for us as a Community.

And finally - next Sunday, December 18th, calendars will be distributed at all of the Masses. These calendars have been made possible through the generosity of the Crestwood Funeral Home, located on West 43rd Street, between 9th and 10th Ave.

Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,

Hoy es domingo de "gaudete" o de regocijo. El domingo de "gaudete" siempre se celebra el tercer domingo de Adviento. Domingo de "gaudete" se debe a la primera palabra de la antifona de entrada y significa ¡alégrense! El morado penitencial del Adviento se reemplaza con rosado, el color de la alegría. Hoy se enciende la tercera vela en la corona de Adviento y la liturgia de hoy da un indicio de que algo alegre aparece en el horizonte. Quizás data desde la Edad Media, cuando la temporada de Adviento tenía un carácter demasiado penitencial, el color rosado señalaba alegremente que la iglesia se acercaba a la Navidad. Aunque hoy en día el color rosado es todavía una señal de alegría navideña anticipatoria, comprendemos la continuidad del Adviento como una temporada de alegre esperanza. La liturgia de hoy nos ayuda a elevar esa esperanza que seguirá hasta la celebración de la Navidad.

En muchos países de América Latina, es la costumbre celebrar una novena de misas en las mañanas inmediatamente antes de la Navidad. Estas misas son típicamente llamadas aguinaldos. Con ese fin, celebraremos estas misas temprano por las mañanas en los días antes del 25 de diciembre (incluyendo el sábado y domingo). Las misas comenzarán el sábado, 17 diciembre. Las misas serán a las 6 de la mañana, seguidas por chocolate caliente o café. Las misas serán celebradas en español. Éstas son misas con música y son muy alentadoras. Todos están invitados a asistir.

De su Comité de Finanzas: Nosotros, como una comunidad de creyentes, tenemos mucho por qué alegrarnos en este año. De acuerdo con nuestro tono de "Juntos Podemos Hacerlo Como Comunidad de la Ascensión," estamos pidiendo este año dos regalos de Navidad para la Iglesia de la Ascensión. El primero sería un regalo monetario de \$250-\$500 – si puede proveer uno, pero cualquier donación adicional será muy agradecida. El segundo regalo es apuntarse en el sistema automático de dar donaciones conocido como Faith Direct (Fe directa – véase el sitio web de Faith Direct – el código de la Iglesia de la Ascensión es "NY 588"). Hemos añadido a muchos feligreses a Faith Direct durante este año pasado pero para ser una parroquia económicamente sostenible necesitamos más apoyo para Faith Direct. Mientras que sabemos que se está pidiendo mucho, esperamos que todos vean el sacrificio como uno de gran valor para nosotros como una comunidad.

Y finalmente – el próximo domingo, 18 de diciembre, se distribuirán calendarios en todas las misas. Estos calendarios se han hecho posibles a través de la generosidad de la Funeraria Crestwood, ubicada en la calle 43, entre las avenidas 9na y 10ma. "Alégrense siempre en el Señor. Repito: ¡Alégrense! El Señor está cerca." (Filipenses 4: 4, 5).

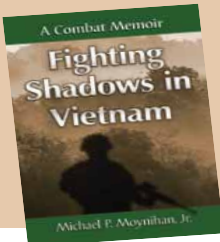
